

To all Christian People to whome these presents shall Come Greeting Know Yee that I Jane Lambert of Marsett widow being aged but ...

I give my nephew Robert Morton of Askrigg Cordwainer ... all that close of ground called Newclose with an out house thereon three acres ... & sic Cattle gates in Bardale & halfe a Cattle gate in the Cow close & halfe a Cattle gate in Marsett Riggsunder the yearly Rent of four shillings

I give my Nephews George, Thomas, Francis & Abraham Morton each of them twelve pence & to my neceis Jane Lambert, Mary [Coo] Marcy Farington & Ellen Howden each of them twelve pence if they be demanded & to John Lambert & his sister Margret Metcalfe each of them twelve pence. I give my Cosen Elizabeth [Robert] Morton wife one black silk hood & to Thomas Morton wife on black serge petty coat & to Francis Morton wife one Camlet Rideing hood & to Robert Farington wife my Common wearing Cote & one shift & to Jane Lambert widow one Coffe & all my other wearing cloths & to Elizabeth Farington one Iron pott & to Jane Morton Robts daughter one brass pot. All the rest ... to my nephew Robert Morton six pound unto his son George Morton for the discharging of my funeral exepnces ... I appoint cousin George Morton son of ye sd George Morton my executor ...
