In the name of God Amen, The twenty eight day of January, In the second year of the Raigne of our Gracious Soveraigne Lord George by the grace of god of Great Britan King defender of ye faith &c Anno Domini 1715[6]. I Roger Tennant of Marsett in the parish of Aisgarth in the County of York Taylor being sick of body but of sound mind and memory doth make this my last will and testament, first I give and bequeath my Soull to Almighty god my maker and my body to the earth from whence it came to be buried in such decent maner as my executor hereafter named shall think fit. And as for the disposur of my personall estate, first it is my Will and mind and I doe give & bequeath unto my sone John Tennant one shilling, And I doe make constitute and appoint my sone Alixander Tennant my sold executor In witness whereof I have here unto put my hand and seal the day and year first above written.
