I give and bequeath to my eldest daughter Philis Tennant Thirty Pounds and to my other two daughters Ann and Elener each of them fifteen pounds to be immediately paid after my decease out of my personal estate. It being a Legacy left to them by their grandmother Philis Tennant and now in my hand. Also I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Jane and my only son Christopher and to my three daughters, Philis, Ann & Elener all the Residue & Remainder of my personall estate Debts goods, Chattels and Catle, Bonds, Bill & Notesequally devided amongst them ... Except my household goods which I wholly give to my dear wife Jane. Also I give and devise unto my onely son Christopher Tennant all my Real Estate Houses and Lands whatsoever in the parish of Aysgarth .. and my son shall out of my estate .. pay .. three hundred pounds to my three daughters (that is to say) to my daughter Philis one hundred pounds and to my daughter Ann one hundred pounds and to my daughter Elener one hundred pounds to be paid to them severally when my said son Christopher attains his age of 21 ..

.. appoint my Brother Edward Tennant and my Cousin Amos Robinson of Semmerdale yeomen In whome I repose a speciall Trust and confidence to be my joint Trustees and supervisors ...
