

In the name of God Amen 2nd Oct 1744 I Roger Alderson of Marset .. yeoman being weak in body I give and bequeath unto Dorathey my wife all my houshowld goods to dispose of as she pleaseth, And my dwelling howse so long as she liveth the sum of Two pounds ten shillings yearly ... Likewise I give unto Thomas Metcalfe my Sisters sun the sum of fifteen pounds. And Likewise I give unto Ann Dinsdale my Sisters daughter the sum of ten pounds. And likewise I give unto Sara Metcalfe my Sisters daughter the sum of Ten pounds. And likewise I give unto John Metcalfe my Sisters sun my Dwelling house after the Dearth of my wife and likewise I give unto the said John Metcalfe Ten pounds. And likewise I give unto the said John Metcalfe one Cow Gate in Marsit Cow Close and to enjoy the sayd Cow Gate at my Desease for ever, and out of the Cow gate the sayd John Metcalfe is to pay unto his Sister Sara Metcalfe three pounds which was left as a Legasey by hir Ant Sara Loblow deseased and likewise the said John Metcalfe is to pay unto his Brother Thomas Metcalfe Two pounds out of the said Cow Gate which was left him as a Legasey by his Ant Sarah Loblow deseased and likewise I give unto Christopher Alderson my Nephew whome I likewise constitute make and ordaine my sole executrix and heir of this my last will and testament to wit the Long Dale Midle Fauw with all the Cattle gates except one Cattle gate in Marstie Cow pasture which John Metcalfe is to have
