I .. give .. all my Housing and Land Cattlegates .. at Marsett ... unto my son Robert Lambert ... subject ... pay to my dear wife, his mother the sum of three pounds .. every year ...

I give .. unto my two daughters Margaret and Elizabeth each of them Thirty pounds .to be paid .. by my son Robert ... [in case of non payment.. daughters to enter] one Close of ground called Parrock and one Catle gate in the pasture called Marsett Cow Close And four Catle gates in the pasture called Marsett Bardale And one Calfe gate in Marset Green ... under the yearly Rent of Three Shillings four pence ...
