to son Samuel, all messuages, tenements..at Stalling Busk charged with payment of two hundred pounds to grandson Humphrey Hodgson Hopper

to son Richard all messuages...known as Knights Close near Marsett and beastgates in common stinted pasturs called Close Ing and Bardale pastures charged with payment of two hundred pounds to grand daughter Jane Hopper and payment of thirty pounds yearly to daughter Isabella Hopper the wife of George

Hopper ... in no wise subject to the control of husband George..and if she should ever cohabit or have any connexion with her husband..the said annuity shall be no longer paid

to eldest son Francis Nichols who went abroad many years since if he should be living and ever return into Great Britain and claim the same the sum of five pounds to be paid to him

..household goods and furniture to son Richard and daughter Isabella; George Hopper shall have no control over share given to Isabella
