And from and immediately after her decease I give and devise unto my sons John Hebden and Robert Hebden and my daughter Elizabeth the wife of William Metcalfe their heirs and assigns, all those my three closes or parcels of land situate at or near marsett aforesaid and call respectively the East Longdales, The West Longdales and the Faw, with the barn theron and seven cattlegaits in Marsett Bardale Pasture. To hold the same unto and to the use of my said sons John Hebden and Robert Hebden and my said daughter Elizabeth Metcalfe their heirs and assigns for ever as tenants in common. I give and devise unto my daughter Alice Hebden her heirs and assigns, all that my messuage or dwellinghouse situate at Marsett aforesaid wherein I now reside, with the outbuildings, gardens and appurtenances thereto belonging, and all that my close or parcel of land situate at or near Marsett aforesaid, called the pasture allotment and now in my own occupation and one calfgait and one half of another calfgait in Marsett Green Pasture. To hold the same unto and to the use of my said daughter Alice Hebden her heirs and assigns for ever. I give and bequeath unto my said daughter Alice Hebden all my household furniture, plate, linen, china and dairy utensils. To hold the same unto my said daughter Alice Hebden her executors, administrators and assigns absolutely and beneficially I give and bequeath unto my said wife Elizabeth Hebden all the rest residue and remainder of my personal estate not hereinbefore otherwise give or bequeathed to hold the same unto my said wife Elizabeth hebden. All the rest residue and remainder of my personal estate not hereinbefore otherwise given or bequeathed to hold the same unto my said wife Elizabeth Hebden, her executors, administrators and assigns absolutely and beneficially. And I appoint my said daughter Alice Hebden sole executrix of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand the ninth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty seven
