In the name of God Amen the second daye of Februarie in the yere of our Lord god one thousand six hundredth thirteen I Francis Hesleden of Marset in the parish of Askrigg and in the Countie of Yorke Laborer, Sicke in bodie but of good & perfect remembrance thanks bee to almightie god Doe make and ordaine this my last will or testament in manner and forme following First I commend my soule into the hands of almightie God my onely Creator rusting to be saved by the merits, death and passion of Jesus Christ my onely Redeemer & advacate And my bodie to be buried in the Church yarde of Askrigg ~~Item I give unto my base gotten child ten shillings~~ And all the [Reste] of my goods and Chattells moveable and unmoveable I give and bequeath wholie unto MARGarett Hesleden my wiffe James, Eph[anne] & Francis Hesleden my children. Also I doe make Robte Tompson of Marcet aforesaid executor of this my last will or testament Witnesses hereof Francis Lambert Thomas Tompson & [Robt] Tompson
