I give my younger son Ather that land which was my father Lowrance to enter to halfe on it at one and twenty years of age and the other halfe at his mothers discease.

I give my father Lowrance Hebdin the sum of three pounds enduring his life time and for want of payment of that money to enter to the one halfe of that estate which was his own.....
