Being asked by Mr John Pepper what he would give or leave in case he dyed to Phillis wife of Leonard Bowman whoe had waited of him in his sickness he the said deceased replyed that none of his relacions had done any thing for him & that she said Phillis Bowman had been very carefull of him in his sickness he therefore did then and there declare that he had forty shillings oweing to him by William Wright as an Annuity And what remain of the said summe after his funeral exepences discharged he did give unto the said Phillis Bowman
