In the name of god Amen I James Thompson of Marsett in Wensladaile sicke in body but sound in memory thanks be to almightie God doe make this my last will in manner and forme as followeth First I bequeath my soule to God and my body to be buried wthin the church yeard of St Andrewes at Askrig and my goods as followeth vizt First I give and bequeath unto my sonne John and my daughter Alice all my whole tenement reserving the parte due unto my wife for her widdowright for the whole tearme and space of six years and all my goods equally unto my wife Agnes my sonn John and my daughter excepting one colt stagg wch I give unto my sonne Christopher and one tupp hogg wch I give unto my sonne in law Alexander Lambert of Marsett, and to my brother Thomas one suite of apparell And I doe hereby appointe my sonne John my executor willing him to performe and execute my will herein and to se all my debtes truely discharged and my legacies paid witnesses hereof Francis Thompson
