I give all that my houses, lands, tenements ... in Marsett of ye ancient yearly rent of two shillings unto my wife Ellin als Hellen Thwaite during her life and after unto my daughter Aliche Thwaite .. upon condition that she the said Aliche shall pay unto my daughter Dorothy Thwaite five and thirty pounds next after my wife decease ...

I give my daughter Dorothy one cow and one Table Chist. I give my daughter Aliche one Black mare and one Twinter whye or heffer, also one Cupboard after my wifes decease.

All the rest to my wife Ellen ...
